Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

As of today, 33 residents and 17 staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. 5 residents are being cared for on our dedicated COVID-19 unit and all but 4 employees have returned to work. We will be conducting another round of all staff/all resident COVID-19 testing on Monday, June 29, 2020 and will report the results on our web-site as they come in later next week.

While we focus on stopping further spread of this virus in our facility by continuing to follow the recommendations of our health officials and practicing the enhanced safety measures we have previously reported to you, we also want to make sure our residents' daily routines are as normal as possible and that they are having some fun, too!
