Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update on the status of COVID-19 in our facility.

As always, our goal is to be transparent and provide you with weekly updates on the status of COVID-19 in our facility, including the current number of positive cases in our facility and our current visitation status.

We are happy to report that we currently have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility.

VISITATION STATUS

As of June 1st, we have increased our visitation times to Monday - Friday 9am to 6:30pm and weekends from 9am to 3pm. Outdoor visits are always preferred and a reminder that masks are required for residents and visitors while visiting inside or outside. Please call the Receptionist at 262-297-6300 to schedule a visit. If you do not feel comfortable entering the building, window and virtual visits are still available. If for any reason these visitation times do not work for you, please call 262- 297-6300 and we can try to accommodate your schedule. Visitors will be screened upon arriving, they will be asked to wash their hands, wear a mask, and go directly to the resident's room, patio, or designated visitation room, while social distancing.

Please remember, if the county positivity rate increases, or if a staff member or resident would test positive for COVID-19, the indoor visits would stop until required resident and staff testing is completed.

VACCINATION CLINIC COMING SOON

We are pleased to announce that we are scheduling another COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic for later this month for our residents and staff here at the Pavilion. If any of our residents are interested in receiving the vaccine or anyone would like to hear more information, please contact our Infection Control Nurse, Heather Pierce at 262-297-6346, and she would be happy to connect and discuss the vaccination process with you.
